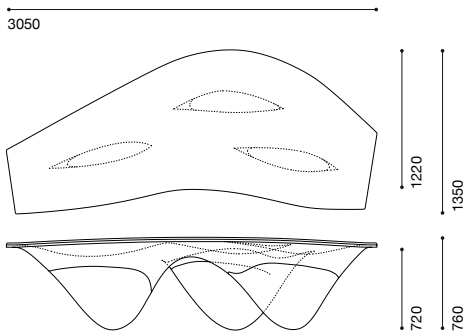


# Aqua Table

The voluptuous Aqua Table is an uninterrupted whole, a curious and curvaceous form that invites viewers to engage with it. Standing as an impressive centrepiece it delivers a stylish focal point. The three fin-like legs of the Aqua Table appear to be in motion and register as gradients on the gently undulating tabletop. Eight coats of high-gloss automotive paint are applied and polished by hand to make a striking surface capable of reflecting light in flowing pools and waves. This design is challenging, daring and the work of one of the greatest talents the contemporary design industry has known

*Notes: 4 or more people required for handling. While uncrating ensure all jewellery, watches etc are removed to avoid causing scratches to the surface.*

**Notes**

- This design should not be exposed to direct sunlight, use in an ambient environment and protect against exposure to temperatures below 4°C and above 40°C. Avoid contact with heat sources.
- Do not pour hot liquids on the surface (ie coffee, tea) . If this happen accidentally the table should be dried immediately to avoid the liquid soak the surface.
- Not suitable for outdoor use
- Satin-matt not recommended for use within high traffic areas.
- This piece is not suitable for airfreight. For exports, please ensure is transported via sea freight in a temperature controlled container. Shipping in temperatures above 30oC or air freighting could result in severe & irreparable damages.
- Please retain the crate for any future transportation or long-term storage.

**Care & Maintenance**

**Satin-matt polyester:**

The table should first be dry dusted with a clean, cotton cloth. If wet cleaning is required , the item should be cleaned without pressure using a soft, slightly damp sponge using deionised water (tap water contains salts that can leave a residue on the surface of the polyester) with a mild, non-coloured detergent, such as Ecover Washing Up liquid. If this method is used, the table should be dried thoroughly using a foam sponge in order to avoid temporary streaking and residue. Do not use cotton cloths or other high lint materials at this point.

**High-gloss:**

Same as above, however, it can be polished with a lint free cloth. Avoid contact with certain solvents, including white spirit, toluene based products and acetone (Beware of many household cleaning products and polishes as these may contain potentially damaging solvents).
